What the job looks like

A typical trip includes:

- Detailed pre-trip inspection and documentation
- Coordinating luggage or team equipment loading
- Highway driving across provinces
- Hotel and venue logistics
- Maintaining Hours of Service compliance

No two trips are identical, but professionalism is constant.

- Safely operate 40–56 passenger motorcoaches
- Maintain compliance with NSC and Hours of Service regulations
- Communicate clearly with clients and dispatch
- Manage trip timing and logistical adjustments
- Maintain clean vehicle presentation
- Complete required inspections and reporting
